It was founded in 1996 with its headquarters in Goa; major hubs in Delhi and Bhopal, and programme sites in many parts of the country. Sangath's mission and expertise lies in developing and evaluating mental health interventions to be delivered through existing public systems. Its major thematic areas are: Child development and disability; adolescent health; mental disorders; and ageing. Sangath was awarded the prestigious MacArthur Foundation International Prize for Creative and Effective Institutions in 2008 and the WHO Public Health Champions Award for India in 2016.

## About the project

The SAHARA program focuses on scaling up evidence based 'task sharing' interventions for perinatal mental health and early child development through delivery of comprehensive primary mental health care for first 1000 days of life. Sangath has successfully digitized Thinking Healthy Program- Peer delivered (THPP); an evidence-based task sharing intervention for perinatal depression and developed Lalan Palan, a video- based parenting intervention for early child development.

We aim to scale these two interventions across 8 districts of Madhya Pradesh by digitally training community-based workers (ASHAs and Anganwadi workers) and provide them continuous supervision.
