## About Sangath

Sangath ([www.sangath.in](http://www.sangath.in)) is one of India's leading mental health research non-profit organisation. It was founded in 1996 with its headquarters in Goa; major hubs in Delhi and Bhopal, and programme sites in many parts of the country. Sangath's mission and expertise lies in developing and evaluating mental health interventions to be delivered through existing public systems. Its major thematic areas are: Child development and disability; adolescent health; mental disorders; and ageing. Sangath was awarded the prestigious MacArthur Foundation International Prize for Creative and Effective Institutions in 2008 and the WHO Public Health Champions Award for India in 2016.

## About the project

The SAHARA program focuses on scaling up evidence based 'task sharing' interventions for perinatal mental health and early child development through delivery of comprehensive primary mental health care for first 1000 days of life. Sangath has successfully digitized Thinking Healthy Program- Peer delivered (THPP); an evidence-based task sharing intervention for perinatal depression and developed Lalan Palan, a video- based parenting intervention for early child development.

We aim to scale these two interventions across 8 districts of Madhya Pradesh by digitally training community-based workers (ASHAs and Anganwadi workers) and provide them continuous supervision.

## About the role

The intern will be responsible for the following:

### ➤ Video Upload & Channel Management

- Upload videos on the DWCD Department's official YouTube channel as per the approved monthly content plan.
- Ensure proper titling, descriptions, tags, and thumbnail selection for all uploaded content.
- Monitor and maintain channel hygiene (playlists, organisation, accessibility).

### ➤ Video Editing

- Receive raw video footage from AWWs and Anganwadi Supervisors and perform basic to intermediate editing.

  - Conduct or support online training sessions for Anganwadi Workers and Supervisors on how to click photographs and record videos in the field.

  - Follow up to ensure consistent quality of footage being submitted by field workers.
- **Monthly Content Plan**
  - Prepare a monthly plan for video uploads in coordination with the LP project team.
  - Track upload schedules, ensure timely publishing, and share a status update at the end of each month.
- **Reports & Presentations**
  - Create PowerPoint presentations for internal and external audiences as assigned.
  - Prepare monthly progress reports documenting activities completed, challenges, and way forward.
  - Support the team in any ad hoc documentation or data compilation tasks.
