#### About the position:

We are looking for an enthusiastic, innovative and self-motivated individual, with excellent communication and organisational skills to join an exciting new 3-year Being Initiative-funded programme (STEER). Programme partners include Indian Institute of Technology Bombay (IITB) (India), Sapien Labs Centre for the Human Brain and Mind, Krea University (India), University of Keele (UK), and Caring From Distance (CFD) (Vietnam). The programme aims to advance understanding about how impaired cognitive and social development during preschool years serves as a mechanism by which stressors, including childhood trauma, violence, conflict, and media, contribute to anxiety and depression in youth. We will investigate these mechanisms in Rewari, Haryana, where we have established the SPRING birth cohort.

The Community Engagement Coordinator reports to the Program Director.

#### Overview of role:

As a key member of the programme management team, this role will lead the design and implementation of the programme's youth engagement and lived experience strategy in Rewari. The main goal is to encourage and support young people, especially those with lived experience of mental health challenges like anxiety and depression, and related stakeholders to actively participate in the programme—especially those from underrepresented groups.

This includes:

- Coordinating applications and activities for the Lived Experience Advisory Panel (LEAP)
- Supporting outreach, awareness, and recruitment efforts

- Sharing key findings from the programme (STEER) in creative and accessible ways, tailored for youth, community, and expert audiences.

The role will work closely with programme partners and youth collaborators to ensure meaningful and inclusive involvement across all programme activities.

The post-holder will be provided opportunities for professional development in mental health research methods and leadership building and attendance at relevant national conferences.

#### **Key responsibilities:**

- 1. Lived Experience engagement responsibilities
  - Lead all community and lived experience engagement activities within the STEER programme, in close coordination with the research team and partners.
  - Encourage and coordinate engagement of youth and their stakeholders in Rewari through the Lived Experience Advisory Panel (LEAP).
  - Organise quarterly LEAP workshops (online and in-person)
  - o Organise and support training of LEAP members on STEER study data analysis methods
  - Develop Information, Education and Communication (IEC) materials co-created with LEAP.
  - Support LEAP participation in the Theory of Change (ToC) workshops
  - Identify and manage vendors for LEAP-related activities, including drafting contracts and MoUs.

## 2. Public engagement responsibilities

- Design and deliver public engagement activities in community spaces, schools and online platforms to further STEER objectives.
- Disseminate co-created IEC materials via blogs, social media posts and newspaper articles
- o Coordinate with Sangath Communications office for wider visibility.
- Identify new opportunities for communication/engagement through engagement with key health/education stakeholders, researchers and members of the public.
- Support the PI and international collaborators with media engagement and dissemination of research findings.

# 3. Research activities

- Document, analyse and report on the outcomes of LEAP workshops and related activities
- Draft summaries, reports or content for grant proposals, presentations, academic posters or publications, as needed.
- 4. Programme Management Team responsibilities
  - Actively participate in programme management meetings and contribute to decisionmaking on strategy and operations
  - Collaborate with co-investigators to set targets and ensure tracking and reporting of lived experience engagement activities in line with project goals
