About the Programme

The **Mental Health for Schools (MHFS)** programme aims to make mental health education an integral part of school life. Through interactive workshops, counselling support, and school-wide well-being activities, MHFS equips students and educators with practical tools to understand emotions, manage stress, and build resilience. Implemented by Sangath and supported by KPMG CSR, the programme focuses on breaking stigma, creating safe spaces, and ensuring that conversations about mental health are simple, accessible, and empowering for young people.



About the Role

We are seeking a **Project Coordinator** to join the MHFS team and lead day-to-day operations of the programme. This role combines team management, workshop design, facilitation, partner coordination, and data-driven implementation. The ideal candidate will have a strong background in psychology, facilitation, and research.

You will directly supervise and train lay counselors, coordinate with schools and volunteers, support workshop implementation across 6 states, and contribute to monitoring, evaluation, and reporting processes.

Key Responsibilities

Team Management

- Providing ongoing training and supervision to lay counselors to support implementation in schools.
- Coordinate with external consultants, school partners, KPMG volunteers and other stakeholders.
- Submit weekly reports and progress to the project co-lead/lead.
- Attend weekly/fortnightly supervision and team meetings at Sangath.

Workshop Design & Implementation

- Co-design workshops for students, educators, and corporate volunteers.
- Facilitate or co-facilitate volunteer training workshops.
- Assist in outreach and build partnerships with schools and community-based organisations (CBOs) across
 6 States.
- Provide on-ground supervision and troubleshooting during school sessions

Monitoring, Evaluation & Safeguarding

- Support the development and implementation of safeguarding protocols
- Analyze workshop and programme data for reporting and learning
- Co-author the final project report/ research and contribute to documentation and dissemination

Essential Criteria

- Master's degree in Psychology
- 1 to 2 years of relevant experience in facilitation, training, or programme coordination
- Fluency in spoken Hindi along with proficiency in English.
- Prior experience working with adolescents, in school settings or low-income communities
- Understanding of context and respect towards low-income communities.
- Experience managing teams and supporting supervision
- Experience in facilitating online and offline workshops/ awareness sessions.
- Strong communication skills to build and maintain partnerships.
- Demonstrated research or documentation skills.
- Commitment to the 9-month programme duration (August 2025 March 2026)



Desirable Skills:

- Experience in co-developing mental health or life skills-based workshops
- Comfort with data collection, analysis, and reporting
- Prior exposure to working in multi-stakeholder programmes (NGOs, schools, volunteers, etc.)
