About the Project

MANTHAN study aims to develop and evaluate the effectiveness of a Participatory Action Research (PAR) and Theory of Change (Toc) informed rural primary depression care implementation model to integrate depression care into primary care settings. In phase-1, we will engage rural community members, primary care staff, and health officials to understand perspectives on depression care through interviews, group discussions, and activities to inform a 'theory of change' workshop and a co-developed care model, refined through iterative

community consultations. In phase-2, the final implementation model will be evaluated through a

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cluster-randomized controlled trial with nine rural health centres (PHCs/SHCs) deploying the model (with routine district team support) and nine 'control' rural health centres (PHCs/SHCs) delivering depression care through routine district team support alone. We will evaluate model effectiveness through a comparison of depression case-detection rates between arms (primary implementation outcome) in addition to secondary outcomes of cases referred to the health centre doctor, cases initiated on treatment, and followed up for continued care. We will also compare patient depression remission outcomes at 3-month follow-up between arms (primary patient outcome). We will also cost the development and delivery of the model using WHO's health system building blocks. If effective, the model could be scaled across 1,200 rural health centres (PHCs/SHCs) in Madhya Pradesh to complement the government's efforts to integrate mental health care into primary care.

Key Responsibilities

The Liaisoning Officer (LO) will serve as the key contact between the MANTHAN project team, the National Health Mission (NHM) in Bhopal, and district-level health officials. The LO will ensure alignment of project activities within the framework of government priorities, support policy uptake, enable implementation at the CHC/PHC/SHC level, and support institutional partnerships to strengthen mental health systems. The specific job responsibilities of the LO will be as:

- Maintain regular contact with NHM Bhopal (mental health division) and district health officials (including CMHO, DPM, DMHP, CHC, PHC/SHC offices).
- Facilitate approvals, clearances, and other administrative processes (MoU, directives etc.) with NHM/state-level and district-level offices as needed.
- Support the scheduling and coordination of periodic meetings, and field visits involving government officials.
- Ensure timely communication between district health offices and the MANTHAN team to support embedding and trial activities in CHC/PHCs/SHCs.
- Coordinate and track implementation-level performance data submissions, particularly around depression care indicators.
- Facilitate participation of government stakeholders in participatory action research (PAR) consultations, Theory of Change (ToC) workshops, and review meetings.
- Draft and review briefs, reports, and presentations for health systems officials.
- Document key communications and decisions from coordination meetings with MANTHAN, NHM-Bhopal and district teams.
- Provide monthly updates to the MANTHAN leadership on progress, bottlenecks, and action plans involving government engagement.
- Advocate for integration and potential scale-up of the MANTHAN depression care model within NHM's mental health strategies.
- Assist in documenting contributions of health system partners for funder reporting.
- Support the development of project manuscripts.
- Support Sangath activities and other project-related tasks as assigned by the supervisor and project leads.
