The current study using digital tools, like mindLAMP, aims to integrate shared-care for Schizophrenia into Primary Care. This research program, through a Randomised Controlled Trial, evaluates the effectiveness of combining COPSI with mindLAMP, as compared to COPSI alone. It also looks at the benefits of digital phenotyping and assesses the sustainability of shared-care.
