About the project

The SAHARA program focuses on scaling up evidence based 'task sharing' interventions for perinatal mental health and early child development through delivery of comprehensive primary mental health care for first 1000 days of life. Sangath has successfully digitized Thinking Healthy Program- Peer (THPP) delivered; an evidence-based task sharing intervention for perinatal depression and developed Lalan Palan, a video-based parenting intervention for early child development.

We aim to scale these two interventions across 10 districts of Madhya Pradesh by digitally training community-based workers (ASHAs and Anganwadi workers) and provide them continuous supervision.

- Willing to travel regularly for fieldwork in rural or semi-rural community settings

- To conduct community-based implementation work (training, supervision, data collection, monitoring, and evaluation)
- To facilitate training programs for community health workers in mental health promotion, self-help, psychological first aid, maternal mental health (THPP) and early childhood development (Lalan Palan) for two districts
- To provide supervision and remote coaching support to community health workers and primary care health staff for two districts
- To design, prepare, blueprint, and refine (iterative revisions) the resource materials/ manuals for psychological treatment of mental health problems
- To provide counseling sessions (and clinical case management) to service users of the organization. The service delivery can be either in-person, online or both.
- To update and maintain project-related documents/records and contribute to regular reporting of project activities
- To conduct/organize/assist in capacity building efforts including seminars, symposiums, and other training programs conducted by the organization as part of its objectives.
- To contribute to the research activities of the project
